Service followed by Bonfire (a chance to burn your Christmas Trees—real only!) and Bangers (sausages!!!)

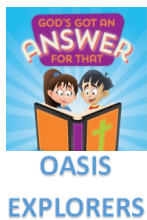
Christingle tubes can be collected from the back of church now.

## December Prayer

'For unto us a child is born, to us a Son is given, the government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.' Isaiah 9:6

As we prepare to celebrate the birth of the Prince of Peace, let's remember His words in John 14:27: 'Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.' Let us pray that in the busyness and anxieties of preparing for Christmas we deliberately make space to connect with our Heavenly Father who made us. We pray that as we learn to live in the peace God promises us, we can radiate that peace to others- bringing calmness and wisdom to tense situations...being a light in the darkness.

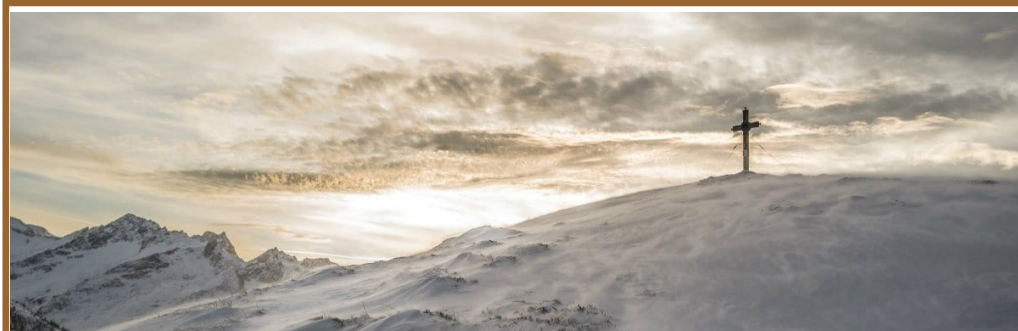
